Day 5. Church and Departments/Ministries ... 2 Chron. 7:14

2 Chr. 7:14 — *If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.*

The English word “church” is derived from the Gr. adjective kyrikon (kyriakon) which means “belonging to the Lord.” The substantial form can be rendered simply as “the Lord’s house” and is used to designate a Christian place of worship.

In the NT, however, “church” translates the Gr. ekklesia which never refers to a place of worship but has in view an assembly of people. In the overwhelming majority of cases, ekklesia indicates a local company of believers.

2 Tim 2:15 But we study, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Jude 1:16 That we’re not murmurers, complainers, walking after our own lusts,

1 Tim 6:18. but are rich in good works, ready to give and willing to share.

Eph 4:16 I pray that the whole body be knit and joined together,

1 Pet 4:10 As each one has received a gift, let him minister it,

Phil 2:4 looking out for the interests of others.

1 Pet 1:22 Let us all fervently love one another with a pure heart,

2 Jn 1:8 so that we do not lose the things we have worked for.

1 Pet 4:7 Let us become serious and watchful in our prayers,

Eph 5:16 redeeming the time, for the days are evil.
